






About SAPH









Goals & Objectives:

- To investigate the incidence, prevalence, and pathobiology of PVD in underserved areas that, to date, have not been well characterized. Also, to identify unique characteristics of the illness including its morbidity and mortality.
- To provide expertise to physicians, scientists, health authorities and healthcare industry regarding new developments on medical technologies and pharmaceuticals relevant to PVD.
- To provide consultative services to health agencies and industry regarding advancing the treatment of PVD.
- To provide expertise to areas with healthcare disparities that will address issues related to the education and training of healthcare professionals in the area of PVD.
- To establish a national database on patients with PVD to allow a meaningful understanding of the similarities and differences in the spectrum of illness between different regions in the kingdom and other countries in the world.
- To focus on improving the treatment of PVD, by promoting basic and clinical research by educating physicians, and by assisting the development and conduct of clinical trials following the highest standards of clinical research.
- To develop a web-based, multilingual educational materials and guidelines on the management of pulmonary vascular disease accessible to people involved in healthcare delivery.
- To conduct conferences and workshops on modern methods of patient evaluation, determine accurate diagnoses, and monitor the efficacy of treatments. Also to promote public awareness through different means including print and electronic media and public seminars
